Claire M. McGuire (26-40) [15]

Best known for being the Players Business Manager from 27 to 32 and again in 36. She helped Bill Darling find the site for the theater, and she also appeared in plays. She was The Crier of the Pilgrims (26), Humpty Dumpty and a soldier (27), The Abbess of Kirklee (28), Red Prince (29), Narrator (32), Queen Brangomar and a duchess (37), a citizen of Paris (40)

William Darling (26-42) [17]

Primarily remembered for designing and helping to build the theater. Also his masks, costumes and sets from 26 through 39. He also was on stage as the Wolf (26), a gardener (27), Ralph (28), the Cassowary Bird (29), a cat (30), the White Knight (31), Saladin, the Donkey (32), the Mayor (33), Prince Bulbo (34), Alfred, the horse (35), Sir Dagobert (36), Prince Rupert (38), Snug, a joiner (41), Mrs. Bennett, Mr. Parker's friend and advisor (a big duck) (42).

Patience Paschall (29-73) [45]

29 Dusky maiden, 31 Poppy, 32 Beggar, 33 Prudence, the rat-catcher's daughter (Mary Remy was John, the rat-catcher) and a townswoman, 36 Yolanda, a shepherdess, 37 a duchess, 40, wrote lyrics and music for *Ali Baba*, 49 a lady of the court, 50 a citizen of Paris, 59 a villager, 60 a servant & chorus, 66 Oz person, 68 lady of Hartford and/or Camelot, 73 Player II.

Also assisted in 51, 53. Through her life she continued to be a friend of the Players, would come to the parties at the Cabin, welcome guests at her home at Hidden Ranch. She left Hidden Ranch to the Mountaineers Foundation ...

Harriet K. Walker (29-74) [46]

She played a variety of parts, including a dwarf (both with Snow White and The Hobbit), Alice's Duchess, many mothers, nurses, aunts, housekeepers, Toad's friend, Mole, several witches, Quince, a carpenter, Mr. Parker, an inventor, Nana, Princess Beauty's nurse, a vagabond player in 48, Hugo a thief (49), Noah's wife (55), Unappetizing Scragg in the 61 *Li'l Abner*, Fleet Foot, an Indian guide in the 63 *Little Mary Sunshine*. Miss Gulch and the Wicked Witch in the 66 *Wizard of Oz*, and Hank Bennett's mother in both the 51 and 68 production of *A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court*. She was Madame Zonga, a Gypsy fortune teller in 71 *The Student Gypsy*. In *The Magic Forest*, she reprised her role as the Wicked Witch in the Oz segment, and with Patience Paschall, was a player who explained the magic of the Forest Theatre to Rip Van Winkle. Her last role was Mother McCleannan in *Brigadoon* in 74. In all, from 29 to 74 She died in 84. She was Players Chairman in 47, and helped reclaim the Theatre from the wilderness after the four year hiatus due to the war.

She was in charge of make-up for 13 of the plays.

She wrote two plays for the Players, *Ali Baba (Produced twice)* and *Under Richard's Banner*.

They met in the Forest Theatre, had their honeymoon at the first Honeymoon Cabin there, where their son Terry claims he was conceived.
