**BREMERTON, WA** – The Mountaineers Players continue their tradition of outdoor theater at the magical Kitsap Forest Theater with the Northwest premier of *Bend in the Road, The Anne of Green Gables Musical*. For four weekends in the summer of 2021 (Saturday and Sunday at 2:00 pm) this popular show will come alive on our forest stage. Both residents of the Kitsap Peninsula and visitors from Seattle and beyond will delight in this heartwarming production at the beautiful Kitsap Forest Theater, located just west of Bremerton.

A quarter-mile trail transports visitors to another time and place where stories for all ages have come to life since 1923. Generations of theatergoers have enjoyed the scenic drive or ferry ride to the theater, and often come early to picnic under the firs before the trail to the theater opens at 1:00 pm. Enjoy our treehouse play structure or hike to Big Tree before or after the show.

Bend in the Road, The Anne of Green Gables Musical: The Northwest premier of this high-energy, brand new family musical (postponed from 2020) is based on the beloved classic novel, "Anne of Green Gables", by Lucy Maud Montgomery with book and lyrics by Benita Scheckel and music and lyrics by Michael Upward. Anne Shirley, an orphan, is mistakenly adopted by siblings Marilla and Matthew Cuthbert to help them on their Avonlea farm. Anne's intelligent, joyous and imaginative ways change the lives of all those around her.

Bend in the Road's themes of finding a home, being an intelligent and independent woman, using the power of imagination and growing up resonate with audiences from all walks of life.
